WARNING AGAINST FRAUDULENT ACTIVITIES

CIPC has become aware of fraudulent activity where Companies receive notification that their entities are in deregistration which in fact it is not the case. The fraudsters then offer to assist with a substantial fee implication.

Please note that there are persons who data mine CIPC data and use such information to solicit work for themselves. CIPC advises that such persons are not associated with the CIPC and customers using intermediaries are doing so at their own risk.
