

NOTICE TO COMPANIES AND CLOSE CORPORATIONS (Notice 45 of 2019)

COMMENCEMENT OF DEREGISTRATION NOTIFICATION TO COMPANIES AND CLOSE CORPORATIONS

The Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) has commenced with the notification process in terms of Companies Regulation 40, 2011 for companies and close corporations referred for deregistration due to non-compliance with Annual Returns.

For the list of companies and close corporations for which the notification process has commenced, kindly refer to the CIPC website www.cipc.co.za / Legislation / Gazettes / Gazette Publication No 201906 date 31 May 2019.


It should be noted that the deregistration status for companies and close corporations in deregistration due to non-compliance with Annual Returns will only be cancelled/uplifted upon the filing of ALL outstanding Annual Returns and the required Audited Financial Statements or Financial Accountability Supplements.

Lastly, continued non-compliance will result in final deregistration of the company or close corporation.
