

## NOTICE TO COMPANIES AND CLOSE CORPORATIONS

### DELAY IN PROCESSING BUSINESS RESCUE PROCEEDING APPLICATIONS (Notice 17 of 2015)

The Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) will like to inform customers and business rescue practitioners of expected delays on specific business rescue proceeding applications due to a lack of processing capacity during March and April 2015. It is expected that processing capacity will reduce to normal by early May 2015.

During the period the expected turnaround times will be as follows:


- CoR123.1 or court orders commencing business rescue proceedings – 2 working days
- CoR125.1 – no turnaround time but processing will be normalised by early May 2015
- CoR125.2 and CoR125.3 – 5 working days

It should be noted that only the stated applications will be affected by the delay. Therefore, processing of CoR123.2 and CoR126.1's currently do not experience delay in processing.
