

Practice Note 3 of 2012

Notice on documents required in respect of applications for liquidation of either solvent or insolvent companies and close corporations

- 1. The following forms must be lodged with CIPC in the event of a winding-up of a solvent company or close corporation:-
 - Form CoR 40.1
 - The special resolution passed by the shareholders
 - JM12 (if liquidated by members)
 - Certified copies of the ID of the director who signed the CoR40.1
- Chapter 14 of the repealed Companies Act, 1973, continues to apply in terms of Item 9 of Schedule 5 of the Companies Act, 2008, in relation to the provisions of the winding-up of insolvent companies and close corporations.

Therefore the following forms must be lodged with CIPC in the event of a winding-up of an insolvent company or close corporation:-

- Form CM26
- Special resolution passed by the members
- Notice of the meeting or cm25a or notice plus cm25
- JM12 (if liquidated by members)
- Cm100(if liquidated by creditors)
- Certified copies of the ID of the director who signed the CM26
