PILOT OF NEW ONLINE FILING METHOD FOR CHANGES RELATING TO AUTHORISED SHARES AS PER FORM COR15.2

The Companies and Intellectual Property Commission (CIPC) is in the process of developing an automated filing method (service) for the filing of authorised share changes as per form COR15.2 which will be initially released as a pilot. CIPC will be contacting selected customers to participate in this pilot to test the service within the live environment. At the completion of the pilot, CIPC will communicate the full launch of service via its website www.cipc.co.za.

The automated filing method will form part of the current e-services transactional website and will allow customers to affect the below listed changes to authorised shares:

- Increase/decrease of authorised shares;
- Conversion from par value to no par value authorised shares;
- Re-classification of authorised shares; and
- Adding new class(es) of authorized shares.
