

AUTOMATIC AVAILABILITY OF CERTAIN RECORDS OF THE CIPC

Section 15(1) of the Promotion of Access to Information Act, 2 of 2000

The Promotion of Access to Information Act, 2 of 2000 ("PAIA"), prescribes that every public body must compile a list of categories of records of that public body, that are automatically available without a requester having to request access thereto.

The following categories of documents are available to the public:
